Tip 1. Look for enduring beauty

Beauty is not skin deep. Loveliness comes from God. Look for it ... in yourself and others. Everyone reflects the grace, attractiveness, and radiant sparkle of God. It's there – always.

Affirm: God made each of us lovely, and He keeps each of us lovely.

Tip 2. Think beautiful thoughts

Good thoughts make you beautiful. Spiritual, positive, happy, loving thinking is revitalizing. It makes you feel good, makes you attractive.

 While grooming: think God-centered, spiritual, beautifying thoughts about yourself and others.

"Immortal Mind feeds the body with supernal freshness and fairness, supplying it with beautiful images of thought and destroying the woes of sense which each day brings to a nearer tomb."

Tip 3. Embrace immortal beauty

Immortal beauty never ages or is lost. It's not genetic, nor a surgical or cosmetic process. It's spiritual, eternal, fresh, continuous day-in, day-out.

• Don't celebrate a birth-day. Have a special day to remember that you are God's totally lovely daughter or son.

Tip 4. Nurture the spiritual qualities of beauty

God has filled you with His beautiful qualities. He made you a beautiful person - kind, honest, courteous, caring, thoughtful, humble, unselfish.

• Each day: Be the beautiful person you are, at home, school, or work. Let others see your beautiful qualities. Live them.

Tip 5. Utilize the recipe for beauty

Use the beauty procedure that doesn't require you to gulp-down, pat-on, massage-in, or work-out. Simply, get away from the false impression that you must do something to the body in order to be beautiful.

 Spend 3 minutes in prayer just for yourself each day. Affirm: I have the beauty of God's calmness, freedom, and harmony. I am at peace.

Tip 6. Stop worrying about fleshly looks

Beauty isn't physical. It's not about being a certain height, shape, size, or looking "in-vogue". Loveliness is within. It's internal, not external.

• Say *no* to worry about beautifying flesh and *yes* to being the person that God created in His perfect image and likeness.

"Beauty, as well as truth, is eternal; but the beauty of material things passes away, fading and fleeting as mortal belief. Custom, education, and fashion form the transient standards of mortals. ... Comeliness and grace are independent of matter. ... Beauty is a thing of life, which dwells forever in the eternal Mind and reflects the charms of His goodness in expression, form, outline, and color."

Tip 7. Practice thinking spiritually
